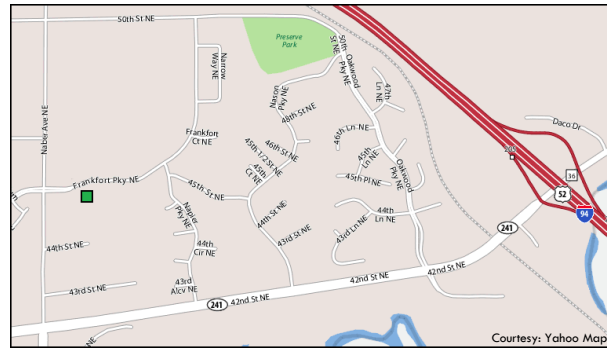

These deadlines only apply for Aptitude Test placement. You still need to have your file complete within your 30 day deadline to be eligible for an interview. Your main application packet must be received by us no later than 2PM on a quarterly deadline to be eligible for the corresponding Aptitude Test date. If your main application is received after 2PM on a deadline date, you would not be eligible to test until the next quarter.

Commercial Apprenticeship

The Minneapolis Electrical JATC Commercial Apprenticeship is a five year program registered through the Minnesota Department of Labor that consists of two components of training: On-the-job training is completed by the Apprentice working full-time with one of our contractors, and Related Training is completed through classroom and lab education. The Apprenticeship will prepare you for a lifelong career in the Electrical Industry as an IBEW Journeyman Electrician.

Application Process

Following are the basic steps of the Application Process:

1. Complete an application form
2. Submit required documentation within a 30 day timeframe
3. Take scheduled Aptitude Test and pass with a score of four or higher
4. Complete an oral interview with the Joint Apprenticeship & Training Committee (if you've met all minimum qualifications; these can be found on our website or by calling us at 763.497.0072)
5. Your interview score will then place you in a pool of eligible applicants, and we will notify you if a position becomes available for you

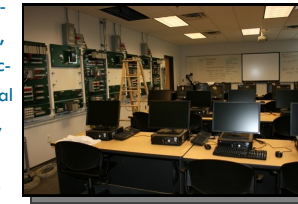
Training Overview

Classroom training for Apprentices is one day a week for 30 weeks a year (August-May). Following are rough outlines of the topics that may be covered each year of your Apprenticeship. Please note that these are not complete lists and are subject to change at any time.

First Year Blueprint Reading for Electricians (Residential), Conduit Fabrication, Electrical Theory (DC), Electrical Systems NEC, First Aid/CPR, Industry Orientation, Job Information, Mathematics, OSHA/Safety & Health Awareness, and Test Instruments.



Second Year Applied Codeology, Blueprint Reading (Commercial), Code Calculations, Electrical Theory (AC), First Aid/CPR, National Electrical Code, Pipebending, Sensitivity Training, and Transformer Principles & Applications.



Third Year Blueprint Reading for Electricians (Industrial), Code Calculations, Electrical Safety-Related Work Practices, Electrical Theory, Electronics, Federal Mediation, First Aid/CPR, Grounding, National Electrical Code, OSHA 10, Overcurrent Protection, Pipebending, and Semiconductors.

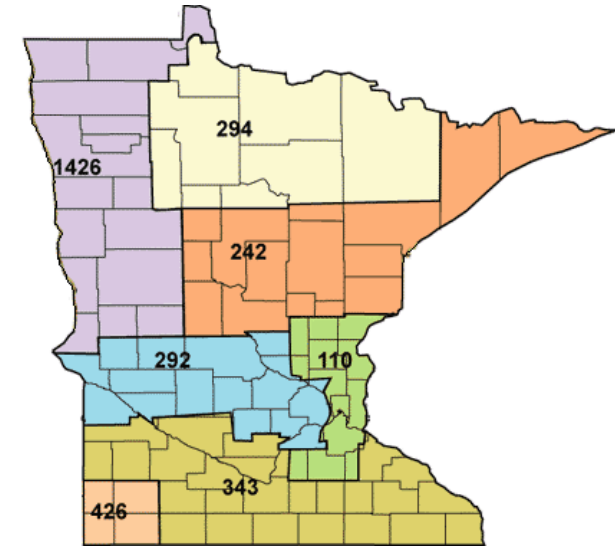


Fourth Year Building Automation, Code Calculations, Digital Electronics, Electrical Theory, Fiber Optics, First Aid/CPR, Hazardous Locations, Lighting Design, Lightning Protection, Motor Controls, Motors, National Electrical Code, and Programmable Logic Controllers.

Fifth Year Air Conditioning, Building Automation, Fire Alarm Systems, First Aid/CPR, Health Care Systems, Instrumentation, National Electrical Code, New Journeyman, Photovoltaic Systems, Power Quality Analysis, Process Control, Programmable Logic Controllers, Security Systems, Sensitivity Training, Structured Wiring, Telephone & Security Basics, and Test Instruments.
